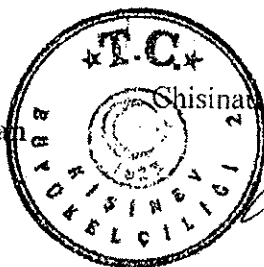

Hereinafter, the Ministry, on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Moldova, informs that the Moldovan side has examined and accepted the content of the Note No. 2019/97271321-Kişinev BE/23082748 of March 1, 2019, and considers the Embassy’s mentioned Note and the present Note of reply as an Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Moldova and the Government of the Republic of Turkey amending the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Moldova and the Government of the Republic of Turkey concerning the reciprocal promotion and protection of investments, signed in Istanbul on 16 December 2016, that shall enter into force on the date of the receipt of the last written notification by which the Contracting Parties inform each other, through diplomatic channels, about the completion of their internal legal procedures required for its entry into force.
