Dear Mr Mija

On 9 November 2022, the European Parliament and the Council adopted Regulation (EU) 2022/2192 laying down specific provisions for the 2014-2020 cooperation programmes supported by the European Neighbourhood Instrument and under the European territorial cooperation goal, following programme implementation disruption. This Regulation was adopted to facilitate the continued implementation of the territorial cooperation programmes after the Russian war of aggression against Ukraine.

In line with the modification of the legal framework, the Joint Operational Programme was adjusted. Therefore, I would like to initiate the amendment of the Financing Agreement. Please see the full scope of the proposed amendment to both Specific and General Conditions of the Financing Agreement in Annex I to this letter.

In line with Article 10 of the Special Conditions of the Financing Agreement, I would like to ask all parties to accept the proposed amendment by replying to this letter (amendment in a form of exchange of letters).
